Queensbury – Scott George, 42, of Queensbury, passed away at home on Thursday, July 30, 2020.

Born on January 4, 1978 in Bradford, PA, he was the son of Patricia (Sandy) Elbrecht of Niskayuna and the late Jeffrey A. George.

In 1992, Scott moved from Bradford, PA to the Queensbury area, graduating from Queensbury High School.
